Eligibility

- Between the ages of 5-20
- Involvement in two or more child serving systems
- Documented evidence of behavioral health diagnosis
- Commitment to utilizing mental health services
- Available for at least monthly face-to-face meetings in home or community setting

Specialized Coordination

Helps clients and families to access a wide array of community resources that will support them in reaching service plan goals. These goals focus on mental health services, social opportunities, educational support, physical health, basic needs, etc.
