

Family Centered Service Coordination

Eligibility

- Two or more family members experiencing mental health symptoms -no diagnosis needed.
- Actively participating or interested in obtaining mental health services.
- Able to meet with staff weekly
- Willingness to close any other service coordination services

Specialized Coordination

Family-Centered Service Coordination (FCSC) is an approach to coordinating mental health services and support when two or more members of the family have a current mental health need. FCSC is intended to focus on the needs of the entire family and coordinates a holistic plan that addresses the individualized needs of each family member as well as the needs, goals, and priorities of the family as a whole.

What's Unique?

- A long-term support for families
- A case management service
- Works within family's natural environment including: home, school, and community.
- Meets with each family weekly.
- Offers a high degree of collaboration with family's team.
- Provides:
 - Assessment
 - Service Planning
 - Referrals, linkages, advocacy, and follow-up
