HSAO Drug & Alcohol Case Management Unit helps
Allegheny County residents access treatment and
services related to the goal of addiction recovery.
Case Management is a voluntary service, offering
the benefit of having an advocate who can
coordinate services that ensure progress toward
recovery goals. Research shows clients with case
managers stay in recovery longer and have a lower
recidivism rate.

The Process

HSAO Case Managers can assist clients in the following ways:

- Screening Identifying the presence of a possible substance use concern, collect information to determine any needs which may result in a referral for detox
- Evaluation Identifying need for drug and alcohol treatment and other concerns which may affect a client's recovery.
- Referral Case manager will make a referral to an appropriate treatment facility, monitor progress, and provide advocacy, and will also connect to other resources as needed
