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The Act 53 Coordinator will provide:

- Screening — Identifying presence of a possible substance use concern, collect information to determine any needs which may result in a referral for detox
- Evaluation — Identifying need for drug and alcohol treatment and other concerns which may affect a client's recovery
- Referral — Coordinator will make a referral to an appropriate treatment facility, monitor progress, and provide advocacy, and will also connect to other resources as needed

ACT 53 Program

Act 53 is a court monitored program for adolescents ages 12 through 17 who have Drug and Alcohol needs. Throughout the course of an adolescent's participation in the Act 53 program the Act 53 Coordinator will provide support to both the child and the family, including ongoing case management. The Act 53 Coordinator will obtain regular updates from treatment providers to monitor treatment compliance/progress. These updates will be provided to the Court at review hearings.
